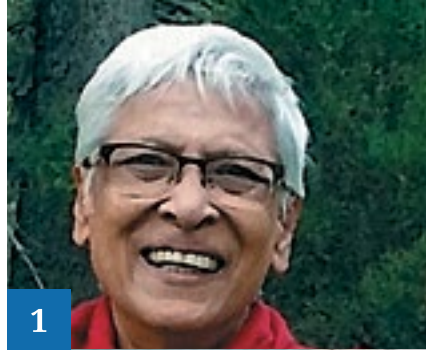


GFA LATEST ALBUM

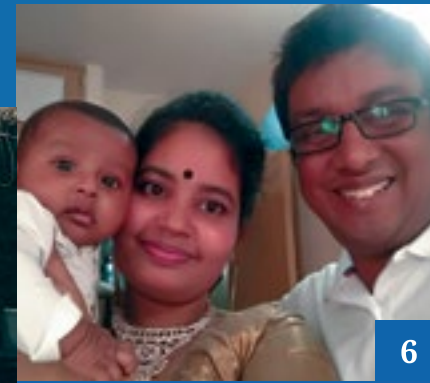

MIKI HOME REPORT JAN-JUNE 2018

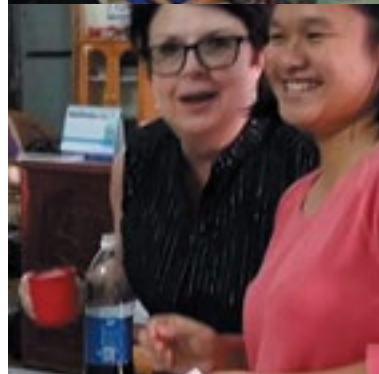
January 2018 crept upon us so quickly and we are now half way through the year.

MEDICAL MISSION (Phnom Krom Village)

Go Forth Asia and New Life Community Church (NLCC) embarked on a medical mission on the 15th of March to Phnom Krom village and visited MIKI Home in between this mission. Locally supervised by Sister Pushpa and Ps Leap, the mission was a tremendous success. Many came to seek medical and dental treatment.

Total Patients 210 villagers
Food Distribution 200 families

Dental Patients 46 villagers
Total Number Saved 34 villagers

Medical Camp

Individual stations were set up to attend to villagers who needed medical attention. 6 stations were established:-

- Registration – to assess medical requirements / conditions
- Doctor
- Dentist
- Pharmacy
- Salvation station
- Children Ministry

TESTIMONY #1

“Praise the Lord for 2 fruitful days of medical mission at Phnom Krom. The village was ripe for reaping as I shared the gospel using the Evangel Cube.

Praise the Lord for good translators in conveying the gospel effectively to the villagers present. Thank God for the answered prayers of the team and the intercessors back in the home church. 34 souls (adults and children) accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. Truly, the harvest is plentiful and we need to urgently ask the Lord of the Harvest to send labourers into the field.” – *Sister Eunice Kiew.*

TESTIMONY #2

“The local health center would not give their approval and asked us to get the approval from the Provincial Health Center. We were told it would take between 2 weeks to a month for our application to be processed.

With the help of someone who works at the Provincial Health Center to expedite the process, we waited. A local pastor was introduced and with his knowledge of Christian applications and through his contact with a few top officials, we were given the approval. The assistant village head, a health center official and police, were present for the 2 days of medical clinics to facilitate security and crowd-control. Praise the Lord!

Honestly, there were moments of uncertainty of the medical clinics becoming a reality. Obviously, God and the prayers of the saints prevailed and the village was blessed with all that was planned. To God be the glory.” – *Sister Pushpha.*

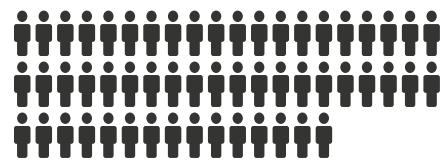

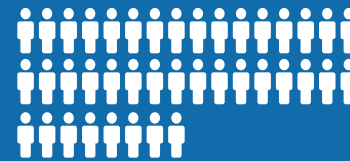

Medical Camp at Comilla

Camp Objectives

- To provide medical services and consultations to the villagers.
- To provide quality medicine, vitamins, antibiotics, etc.
- To increase awareness of basic hygiene and preventive health care.
- To determine the percentage of the most common diseases among the villagers and assess their most pressing medical needs.
- To increase awareness on basic rights.

Briefing

We were able to serve more than 422 patients in Comilla District, which is under the Dhaka Division. Common health conditions are stomach problems, Hepatitis A/B/C, skin diseases, dental problems, fever, mental sicknesses and diabetes. We also conducted blood sugar tests. By God's grace, new cell groups can be established in this area.
